WHAT DOES IT COST TO OPERATE AN AMBULANCE?

These are some of the costs associated with operating an EMS service. Your financial help will ensure that we have the supplies and equipment needed to provide care on every call.

- Equipment, monitors, AED's: \$75,000
- Medical supplies: \$15,000 per year
- Paramedics, insurance & billing: \$75,000 per year
- Maintenance, tires, repairs, gas: \$40,000 per year
- New ambulance: \$250,000-\$350,000



EAST HADDAM AMBULANCE ASSOC. INFORMATION

- EHAA was severely affected by the COVID pandemic with a significant decrease in ambulance calls, supply chain shortages, price increases, and loss of volunteers.
- The State of CT decides who provides ambulance service for the town. EHAA is the designated EMS provider.
- The State of CT determines what EHAA can charge for services.
- Almost 50% of the revenue is uncollectable due to the low insurance reimbursement rates.
- EHAA has a full staff of EMT's who respond to 97% of the calls.
- EHAA is a 501c3 charitable organization. Our EIN is: 06-0953300
- Our OEMS certification # CO41B1
- Both ambulances are inspected and certified by the St. of CT., Office of Emergency Services and DMV as required by law.
- EHAA ambulances receive all required maintenance and repairs.
- EHAA is the only EMS service in CT that reimburses the town for services provided by town employees. EHAA does not receive support from town tax revenue.
